2009 BEACH, TRANSFER STATION, SHELLFISH RENEWALS

TO PURCHASE PERMITS BY MAIL (Please follow instructions carefully to avoid having applications returned):

1. Complete one application for each permit (only one vehicle per form; you can make a copy of form if you need an extra). Mark on each form **which** permit you want for **each** vehicle. *Note: Please use correct mailing as this is the update for our records. We must also have your Chatham street address filled in (in addition to a P.O. Box if you have one) so that Assessors records can be verified. If your name is different from the one listed on the property title, please send us a copy of the portion of the official document which lists you as an owner, i.e. a deed or trust agreement or tax bill which includes your name. Regarding stickers for minor dependents, please send copy of proof of age and/or student I.D.*
2. Include a **copy of your car registration** for **each** vehicle involved (originals are fine if you come in person). **If vehicle is leased** and registration does not identify you by name as lessee, in addition to registration, you must send a copy of either the lease agreement, monthly bill for lease, or proof of insurance with your name. **If registration is in your company name**, you must send proof of employment or proof of insurance naming you as driver in addition to the registration.
3. **Send back both white & yellow copies..** We will return yellow copy with the sticker; then you **must retain it** to purchase a 2nd sticker or a replacement sticker at a later date.
4. Enclose your check **payable to the "Town of Chatham"** in the proper amount (use the form below to figure your total) and mail to Permit Office, 283 George Ryder Road, Chatham, MA 02633. We accept only checks by mail and checks or cash at Permit Dept. **We do not take credit cards.**
5. **SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE IS REQUIRED. IF OMITTED, PERMITS WILL NOT BE MAILED BUT WILL BE HELD at the Permit Dept. for you to pick up after May 15th.**
6. **PERMITS MUST BE AFFIXED TO DRIVER'S SIDE FRONT BUMPER OF THE VEHICLE - NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

If you wish, you may also purchase non-resident licenses for family members or friends who do not qualify for resident permits. We need copies of their drivers' licenses if they have not had prior shellfish licenses in Chatham.

TO PURCHASE FAMILY SHELLFISH PERMITS BY MAIL:

Current Shellfish Permits expire May 31st

1. If you are mailing this *before* your shellfish permit expires, **retain your 2008-2009 Shellfish Permit** and complete the "catch report" below. If you are mailing *after May 31st*, fill out catch report on reverse side of your 2008-2009 permit and mail to us.
2. Enclose your check (*payable to "Town of Chatham."*) Add to total on front if you are also purchasing Beach and Transfer Station stickers.

\$ 10.00 Resident and Non-Resident Taxpayers (over 70).
 Please send copy of driver's license if you have not previously had a Senior License so that we may verify the birth date.

Shellfish Permit holders shall estimate the previous year's shellfish catch and file it with the Shellfish Constable c/o Permit Department. (*If you did not do any clamming, write "0" on the catch report and return.*) **A new Shellfish Permit will not be issued until this form has been completed** by the Permit Holder. The information will be held confidential. We use these figures to track which shellfish beds have been most heavily harvested and therefore need replenishing with seed.

Even if you are not going to renew your license, please fill out the catch report on the bottom of this page or on your license and return to us.
