
Appendix 3: Falmouth Potential Restoration Sites

**Disturbance Type:** Fill **Disturbed Area:** 0.3 acres **Owner:** Town of Falmouth

Assessors' Lot Number: 49A-04-56A-000 Cubic Yards of Fill to be Removed: 5,950

**Comments:** This fill is typical of waste from municipal construction projects (i.e. rocks, dirt and pieces of asphalt). Disposal is a problem due to the distance from the appropriate municipal facility.







**Disturbance Type:** Ditching **Disturbed Area:** 1 acre

Owner: Salt Pond Area Bird Sanctuaries Assessors' Lot Number: 24-15-03A-00A Cubic Yards of Fill to be Removed: 0

**Comments:** Ditching has lowered the water level in this wetland. Some *Phragmites australis* has become established due to the input of road runoff from Route 28A.






**Disturbance Type:** Ditching **Disturbed Area:** 1.1 acres

**Comments:** Elevations should be checked at this site to determine the possibility of saltmarsh restoration.
