Description of the Mattapoissett River Basin prepared for the Mattapoissett River Valley Water Supply Protection Advisory Committee.

Beginning at Route #6 at the town line between Mattapoissett, Plymouth County and the town line of Fairhaven, Bristol County;
thence northerly by the Fairhaven-Mattapoissett town line to Rte. #195;
thence westerly by Rte. #195 to New Boston Road;
thence northerly by New Boston Road to Mortons Lane;
thence northerly by Mortons Lane to Hathaway Road;
thence northerly by Hathaway Road to Mandel Road;
thence northerly by Mandel Road to Perry Hill Road;
thence northwesterly by Perry Hill Road to Main Street;
thence northerly by Main Street to Braley Hill Road;
thence northerly by Braley Hill Road to North Avenue;
thence easterly by North Avenue to the town line between the towns of Middleboro and Rochester;
thence easterly by the said town line to Walnut Plain Road;
thence southerly by Walnut Plain Road to Burgess Avenue;
thence westerly by Burgess Avenue to Neck Road;
thence southerly by Neck Road to Hartley Road;
thence westerly by Hartley Road to Vaughn Hill Road;
thence southerly by Vaughn Hill Road to New Bedford Road;
thence westerly by New Bedford Road to Mattapoissett Road;
thence southerly by Mattapoissett Road to Boat Rock Road;
thence southerly by Boat Rock Road to Rte. #195;
thence westerly by Rte. #195 to an extension of Knollwood Drive;
thence southerly by the extension of Knollwood Drive and Knollwood Drive to Acushnet Road;
thence southerly by Acushnet Road to Mendall Road;
thence southerly by Mendall Road to Rte. #6;
thence westerly by Rte. #6 to the point of beginning.

The above described premises being shown on a plan entitled "Plan Showing The Mattapoissett River Basin, Prepared For Mattapoissett River Valley Supply Protection Advisory Committee, June 2, 1983, Scale: 1" = 2000'."

All of the described premises being in the towns of Mattapoissett, Fairhaven, Acushnet and Rochester.
